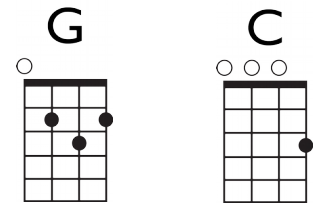


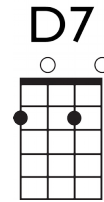


# Jamaica Farewell (Lord Burgess)
